When we reach 3 or more inches of snow on the ground, the snow plow company will be called out to plow the main streets and any open parking areas.

Icy conditions will be monitored by management and the salt trucks will be contacted as needed. Snow of 2 inches or more on the ground in common shared walkways will be shoveled. Residents are responsible for removing snow/ice from their own walkways and driveways.
